

Intravitreal Injection Instructions

You may experience burning, stinging or pain after your injection. This is normal due to the antibacterial prep you received before your injection. Please feel free to use artificial tears as frequently as you need for your comfort. One day after your injection, your eye should begin to feel "back to normal". You may take your usual pain relief medication for any discomfort you may have for the first day.

In the days immediately following your injection, please call our office as soon as possible if your eye suddenly becomes painful, red or you notice a marked decrease in your vision.

Immediately after your injection you may notice a dark spot or "bubble" in your vision. This is normal. You will most likely not be aware of this by the following morning.

Please call our office with any concerns you may have after your injection.
